



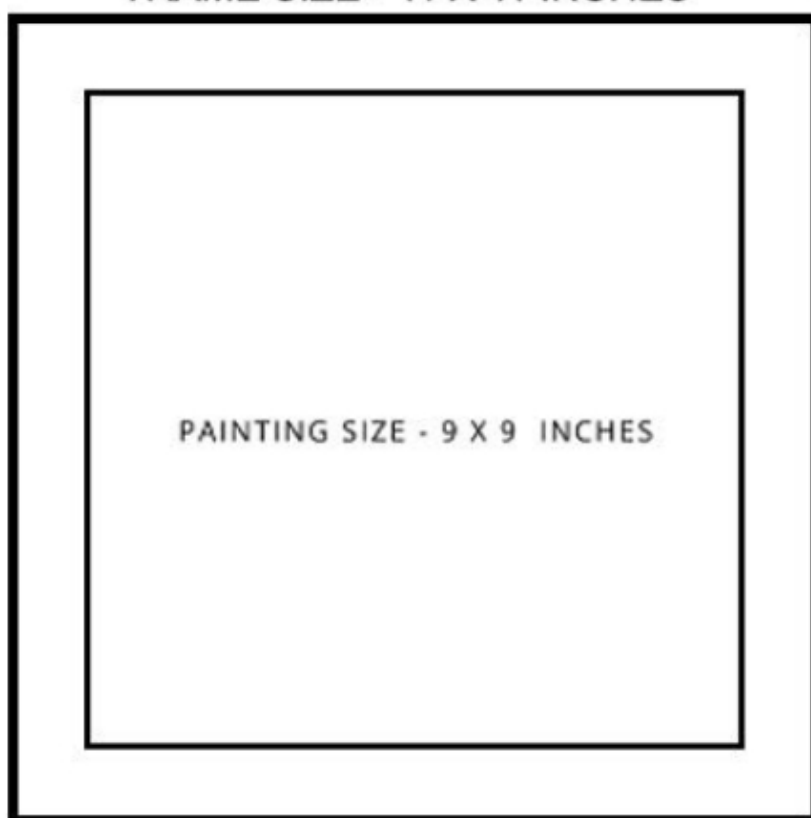
TRADITIONAL TANJORE REVERSE GLASS PAINTING

Reverse glass painting is a fascinating yet comparatively unknown facet of Indian art that flourished in the mid-19th century in Tanjore in Tamilnadu, a South Indian State. These Tanjore glass paintings evoke a sense of class and timelessness with their alluring illustrations of Hindu gods which takes its origin from the murals of the Vijayanagara and acquired its robust forms, architectural details and vibrant colours of this period.
